Meet Olivia: She is 7 years old in primary school who loves to draw and color, play games, go camping and play with her 3 dogs Allie, Bling and Joon. Olivia also has A-T, a rare, genetic disease, combining the worst symptoms of cerebral palsy, cystic fibrosis, muscular dystrophy, cancer, and immune deficiencies. Children who could once run and play, sing and talk, read and write, lose their motor skills one by one, are usually in wheelchairs by age ten, and often do not survive their early twenties. Scientists believe research on ataxia-telangiectasia will help other more prevalent diseases such as Alzheimer's, Parkinson's, and cancer because of their similarities with A-T.

The A-T Children's Project funds research aimed at finding life-improving therapies and a cure for A-T. They are working hard to find a drug that will slow the cells from dying in A-T kids' brains. This will help them be able to walk, talk, eat, and many other things for much longer. And, they

fund the A-T Clinical Center at Johns Hopkins in Baltimore, MD USA where there are now experts who help kids with A-T. These important projects only happen because of funding from friends and families of kids with A-T.
